

Afterwood Boiler Servicing

To keep a boiler running smoothly, extend its lifespan and ensure that you continue to receive RHI payments we would recommend boilers are fully serviced a minimum of once per year. Servicing is an important part of maintaining your system. It keeps your installation safe and reliable, maximises efficiencies and RHI returns.

High use service package Boilers 301kW - 1 Mw

Recommended for boilers exceeding 3000 operating hours/ year or a boiler burning poor quality/high ash fuel

- . Two service visits per annum
- . Includes one full service and one minor service/condition report
- . Includes consumable items replaced in
- . Suitable for boilers burning virgin chip/EN plus pellet and operating less than 3000 operating hours a year
- . Includes one full service and one minor service /condition report

The service requirements of each type of boiler is slightly different, we service boilers in line with manufacturer's instructions and our specialist engineers are familiar with most biomass systems. During a service, the key areas covered are:

- . Check hydronic system
- . Inspections and cleaning of heat exchanger
- . Inspection and cleaning of combustion chamber
- . Inspection and cleaning of primary, secondary, and tertiary air holes and fans
- . Inspection of fuel feed system
- . Inspection of anti-burn back protection/ safety equipment
- . Inspection of automatic ignition system
- . Electrical inspection of boiler connection and control panel
